

COLLEGE EXETER

You may arrive at Killerton at any time on Monday September 21 (but if you come before lunch bring a picnic); and you must arrive by 7.30. To get there by car, leave Exeter by A 38 headed to Taunton; in five miles pass Broadclyst (fine church on left); in one mile at A.A. Box fork left and follow National Trust signs. By bus, take the left and follow (roughly once an hour) to Holly Lodge; Budlake; Cullompton bus (roughly walk back 30 yards, leave heavy luggage on dismounting, corner and turn right; walk  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile. Failing these, be at the college itself at 6.0 pm and there will be transport laid on.
